

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FROM QUALIFYING SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE REVIEW OF DELEGATIONS OF AUTHORITY FOR HARRY GWALA DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY

PROJECT RATIONALE

Bids are invited for the Review of the DELEGATIONS FRAMEWORK for Harry Gwala District Municipality. Harry Gwala District Municipality is required in terms of S59 of the Municipal Systems Act (Act No. 32 of 2000) to develop a system of delegation that will maximise administrative and operational efficiency and provide for adequate checks and balances, and, in accordance with that system.

Project Background

The Municipality has a delegation framework which was developed and approved in 2012. All Municipal Councils have inaugurated their Councillors for the term 2016 - 2021. It became apparent that policies and procedures of Council need to be reviewed to ensure compliance with the legal prescripts and that Councillors are apprised of these documents, as they are utilised by the Municipality for its day-to-day running.

Project Objectives

1. To ensure that the municipality operates within a system of delegations that is approved by Council.

Invalid or non-submission of the following documents will lead to immediate disqualification of the tender:

- Valid tax clearance certificate or SARS pin
- Certified Copies of company or CC documents together with certified copies of members' IDs

- Company Profile
- Central Supplier database registration
