BACKGROUND:

The project was prioritized for the purpose of breaking the cycle of diseases related to water and sanitation. The community was identified as high risk for cholera by the Department of Environmental Health. The project is planned to build 1186 toilet structures for the population of about 7116.

PROJECT LOCATION

The project is located approximately 20km south of Richmond within the Sisonke District Municipality. The project comprises of the following sub-villages Ntabane, KoShange, KoZondi, Mahlabathini and Springvale Mision. The central decimal coordinates are as follows: 30.31 degrees East and 30.10 degrees South.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

To reduce the risk of diseases related to water and sanitation by providing toilets and creating a greater awareness on issues of hygiene with the community members.

SCOPE OF WORKS

Demonstration toilets were 1 Block toilet structure, 1 Archloo toilet structure and 1 corrugated iron toilet structure. The community opted for the corrugated structures because it was the one within the subsidy budget.

The project will be implemented by the Sisonke District Municipality and will implement the project using Municipal Infrastructure Grant funds.
