Offer of Scholarships by Indian Council for Cultural Relations under Africa Scholarship Scheme for the Academic Year 2016-17

The Consulate General of India, Durban invites applications from South African nationals ONLY for the grant of Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) scholarships for various Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate studies in various disciplines. The scholarships will include:

- Return air fare to India.
- Living allowance as prescribed by ICCR.
- Hostel accommodation at prescribed rates / House Rent Allowance (in case hostel accommodation is not available)
- Tuition fee (paid directly to the College by ICCR) excluding laboratory fee for science courses

(Note: For B.E. / B.Tech / Engineering course, candidates must have taken Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics in their School Leaving Examinations.

- Applicant must be proficient in English
- Academic session in India starts in June/July.
- ➤ Applicant must have a valid passport for the duration of the course before submitting application form.
- ➤ Six copies of the Application Form, 6 photos & Fitness Certificate including checklist should be submitted in person to the Consulate General of India Durban.

(Note: Before applying, applicant is advisable to visit the Consulate General of India in Durban (weekdays 1100 – 1500 hrs) for a briefing on terms and conditions of the scholarships, including living conditions.)
